



**Blue Mood Poet Basic Option** – change your final rhyming word to also change the poem’s meaning

**Examples:**

*simplify*

*pacify*

*terrify*

*dignify*

*justify*

*identify*

*quantify*

*sanctify*

*change to your own choice...*

**Blue Mood Poet Advanced Options 1** – change your ‘type of mask’ word [e.g. *beauty*] to agree with or challenge your chosen mood from above

**Examples:**

*cruelty*

*sleep*

*delight*

*change [!]*

*indecision*

*spontaneity*

*humour*

*kindness*

*change to your own choice...*

**Blue Mood Poet Advanced Option 2** – change your colour ‘of reciting’

**Examples:**

*bottle green*

*brick red*

*ash gray*

*deep sky blue*

*electric yellow*

*flamingo pink*

*green lizard*

*harmonious rose*

*iguana green*

*jasper orange*

*change to your own choice...*

**Blue Mood Poet Advanced Option 3** – if you’ve changed your colour, your choice of image [e.g. *cloudless morning sky*] might need a change too, though consider the rhyming words that end the poem...

**Blue Mood Poet Advanced Option 4** – change anything else! If you want to keep literal sense, think about linking action/feelings [e.g. *muffled* poems as *filtered* through something, whereas *pneumatic* poems as *fog-horned* through something] – but you can be as absurd and unconnected as you like!
